The table on the following page has been created to **assist** you in **comparing** and **evaluating** the selected journals at a **single glance** based on 13 **key entries**, including impact factor, frequency, and publishing charges. Selection of the most suitable journal can considerably improve the chances of acceptance of a manuscript, thus helping you publish faster. This table will help you select the most suitable journal for your manuscript (based on the *recommended submission order*, entry 2). The recommended submission order is important because academic and publishing ethics dictate that you submit your manuscript to only one journal at a time. The table will also help you assess the type of modifications (e.g., word count, number of figures, and in-text citation format) you need to make in order to improve the likelihood of acceptance in the indicated journals (entry 11). Entry 12 in the table will help you decide which of the recommended journals is most relevant to your manuscript in terms of domain, topic, scope, and type of article. Submitting to journals that publish papers on topics similar to that of your manuscript will improve the chances of acceptance. If your manuscript focuses on a relatively novel topic or describes a relatively less-known or new method, you can use entry 13 to identify journals that have published articles on topics that are similar to or closely connected with the topic of your manuscript.

Following the suggestions and recommendations listed in the journal selection reports considerably increases the chances of acceptance of your manuscript; however, Wallace cannot guarantee acceptance or publication of the manuscript by the selected journals.
